

Trumpet/Trombone Doubling Instructions Part #2

Valve and Slide Conversions

Trumpet in B \flat	0	1-3	1-2	1	0	1-2	2	0
Trombone Positions	1	6	4	3	1/6	4	2	1

Trombone Positions	3	1	6	5	3	1	4	3

After you have played through these slide/valve combinations for a while, you will begin to see repeated patterns which will make the learning process much easier, such as the following-

1. All open fingerings are played in 1st position on trombone.
2. All second valve fingerings are played 2nd " " " .
3. All first valve fingerings are played in 3rd " " " .
4. All first & second valve " " " 4th " " " .
5. All second & third " " " " 5th " " " .
6. All first & third " " " " 6th " " " .
7. All first, second & third fingerings are played in 7th Position.
